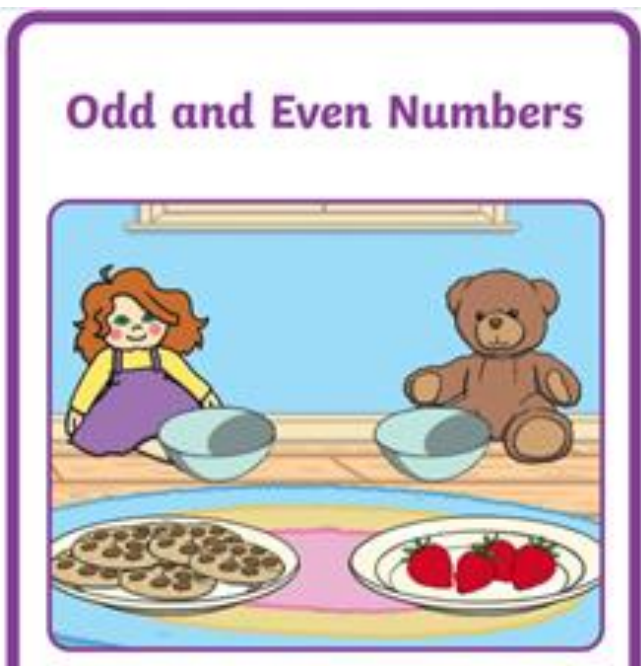

Handwriting- Please encourage your child to practise writing his/her name and forming their letters correctly. We sent home a sheet containing the letter formation rhymes that we use in school in the Autumn term. Please refer to this when supporting your child at home.

Literacy, Understanding of the World - During the week, the children have been excited to see the chicks hatch from eggs in the incubator. To consolidate and extend this learning, we will be finding out more about the life cycle of a chick and learn how to care for them. We will write about the life cycle of a chick and label a chick.

Maths- This week we have been learning about odds and evens. Have a go at this activity at home using any items of food that you wish.



- How much food is there on the plate? Do you think this is an odd or an even number?
- There is one piece left over. Does this make the number odd or even?
- Now we have counted out the food on the plate, how can we check what we have found out?
